

COOKIE POLICY

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on the user's device when visiting certain websites.

They allow a website to function properly, remember certain preferences, facilitate navigation and, where the user has given consent, analyse the use of the website or provide certain third-party functionalities.

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, what types of cookies may be used on **www.ecobelman.com**, their purposes and how users can manage their preferences.

2. Website operator

The website and the processing carried out, where applicable, through cookies are the responsibility of:

3. Types of cookies

3.1. Technical or strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary to allow users to browse the website and use its different options and services.

They may be used, among other purposes, to:

- enable the basic operation of the website;
- manage technical functions;
- maintain website security;
- remember options directly selected by the user;
- technically manage navigation between different language versions of the website.

These cookies do not require consent when they are strictly necessary to provide a service expressly requested by the user or to enable communication over an electronic communications network.

3.2. Preference or personalisation cookies

These cookies may remember certain choices made by the user in order to facilitate navigation, such as language preferences.

Where a preference is directly selected by the user and the cookie is used exclusively to provide that functionality, it may qualify as a technical cookie.

Where personalisation is based on additional information obtained about the user and is not strictly necessary, prior consent will be required.

3.3. Analytics or measurement cookies

These cookies may provide statistical information about how users interact with the website.

The documentary audit carried out has not allowed us to reliably confirm the use of a specific analytics service such as Google Analytics, Matomo or another equivalent service.

Therefore, no specific analytics cookie is attributed to ECOBELMAN, S.L. unless its actual use can be technically verified.

If an analytics service requiring consent is introduced in the future, this Cookie Policy and the consent mechanism must be updated before the service is activated.

3.4. Third-party cookies

Third-party functionalities integrated into a website may involve connections with external providers and, depending on their technical implementation, the use of cookies or similar technologies.

The website contains links to **Instagram** and a **YouTube** channel. The existence of such links does **not by itself mean that their cookies are installed on the website**. Third-party cookies may only be installed when the user accesses those platforms or when external content capable of setting such cookies is embedded in the website.

For this reason, such services are not listed as cookies installed on www.ecobelman.com unless their installation can be technically verified.

4. Cookies used on www.ecobelman.com

The following classification must always correspond to the technologies actually active on the website:

Technical / necessary	Website operation and navigation	Not required where legally exempt
Preferences	Remembering user-selected options, where applicable	Depends on the purpose
Analytics	Usage measurement and statistics	Yes, where not exempt

Category	Purpose	Consent
Advertising / marketing	Personalised advertising or tracking	Yes
Third-party	Functions provided by external services	Yes, where non-essential cookies are involved

ECOBELMAN, S.L. must keep the cookie inventory updated with the exact name, provider, purpose, duration and category of every cookie actually installed.

5. Legal basis

Strictly necessary cookies are used where necessary to operate the website or provide a service requested by the user, in accordance with applicable law.

Non-essential cookies will only be used where the user has provided valid consent.

Consent must be freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous.

6. Cookie settings

Where consent is required, the website must provide a mechanism allowing users to:

- accept all cookies;
- reject all non-essential cookies;
- configure cookies by category;
- obtain information about their purposes;
- modify or withdraw their consent at a later time.

The configuration mechanism must remain accessible so that users can change their preferences.

7. Withdrawal of consent

Users may withdraw their consent at any time through the cookie settings panel.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before consent was withdrawn.

8. Third-party cookies and external links

The website may contain links to third-party websites and platforms.

The website currently contains links to services such as Instagram and YouTube.

Once users leave www.ecobelman.com and access such services, the privacy and cookie policies of the relevant providers will apply.

9. International data transfers

Where third-party services involve international transfers of personal data, ECOBELMAN, S.L. shall ensure that such transfers comply with applicable data protection legislation.

10. Browser settings

Users can also configure their browser to accept, block or delete cookies.

Disabling certain technical cookies may affect some website functionalities.

11. Changes to this Cookie Policy

ECOBELMAN, S.L. may update this Cookie Policy when necessary, particularly when new services, technologies or cookies are introduced or when applicable legislation changes.
